

Aviation Pilot Training: Online Options

Indian Hills Community College

Students can begin the 21-month Aviation Pilot Training A.A.S. Degree by completing up to 6 online courses (or 17 semester credits) of the degree program.

The courses offered the 1st term of the degree program starting in the Fall or Spring include:

AVI135-02 Private Basic Ground I	(3 credits)
AVI190-02 VFR Communications	(2 credits)
AVI220-02 Aviation Meteorology	(3 credits)

The courses offered the 2nd term of the degree program starting in the Winter or Summer include:

AVI110-02 History of Aviation	(3 credits)	
AVI136-02 Private Basic Ground II	(3 credits)	(Prerequisite: AVI135)
AVI150-02 Aerodynamics	(3 credits)

3. Check www.indianhills.edu/register to see when online registration is open for the Fall or Spring term, register completely online, and be sure to select the "02" online section of the course or courses you would like to take.
4. Obtain any books, videos, or software before the course begins. Review the syllabus for your course(s) (available in MyHills) to see what is required.

When you continue your courses at the Ottumwa Campus you will need to complete additional items for the Aviation Pilot Degree program including making a \$100 deposit and submitting a medical certificate and positive identification.
