

Higher Learning Commission Invites Third-Party Comment

Indian Hills Community College is seeking comments from the public about the college in preparation for IHCC's periodic evaluation by The Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

Federal regulations regarding higher education require that accrediting agencies allow for public comment on the qualifications of those institutions under consideration for accreditation.
